

- 60-40 split
- Forestry/woodland management
- Organic operations

- Special payment rates are available for beginning farmers & limited resource farmers
- NRCS conservation technical assistance is always available

# Payment Schedules

- No longer percentage-based
- Foregone income
- Streamlined process
- Faster payments
- Permits inflation increases within existing contracts
- Offers more consistency

- Seek partners with common goals
- Actively participate in a watershed/landscape planning initiative
- Talk to your organization's State Technical Committee representative
- Respond to an RFP (MRBI or CCPI)
